- 1.1 The Texas Workforce Commission (TWC) is requesting a bid for components comprising a technology solution for a vocational rehabilitation customer in the San Antonio, TX area (zip code 78249).
- 1.2 **TWC will accept electronic email submission bids only.** Hard copy bids will not be accepted or processed.
- 1.3 Bids must be returned to TWC not later than 10:00 a.m. (CT), **May 29, 2023.** Late bids will not be accepted.
- 1.4 TWC is not responsible for Offers received late, illegible, incomplete, or otherwise considered disqualified due to failure of electronic equipment or operator error.

2. GUIDANCE FOR BID PREPARATION:

- 2.1 Each bidder by signing the bid form certifies that their bid meets or exceeds all mandatory specifications set forth in this IFB.
- 2.2 An authorized officer of the vendor must sign the bid. Bids must be responsive to the specifications contained herein, but may contain additional information considered pertinent by the bidder. TWC reserves the right to not make an award from this IFB.
- 2.3 Brand and model numbers shown on the bid form are indications of desired quality only and aren't intended to be restrictive. Indicate the brand and model number(s) bidding in the spaces provided.

3. CONTRACT AWARD

Award will be made by item, groups of items, or on an "all or none" basis, whichever TWC determines is in its best interest.

4. CONTRACT TERM

Date of award thru March 2024.

5. WARRANTY:

Manufacturer's standard warranty applies.

6. DEMONSTRATION AND TRAINING:

Successful bidder shall provide appropriate levels of demonstration/training for any applicable items, devices, or equipment upon completion of set up and/or installation.

7. FREIGHT:

Delivery shall be FOB destination, prepaid and allowed (delivered pricing) to San Antonio, TX (zip code 78249). If freight charges will be incurred, the charges **must** be included in the bid pricing. Specific delivery address and instructions will be provided to the successful bidder(s) upon award.
