- 1 Introduction -The Commission approved a set of initial Adult Education & Literacy PY19
- 2 targets for Participants Served on August 27, 2019, based on negotiations with grantees
- 3 conducted over the prior several weeks. However, at that time, we recommended that the
- 4 agency allow grantees to request renegotiation of these targets. This was in consideration
- 5 that demands can change over the year and that if we want local providers to be responsive
- 6 to local needs, it made sense to account for changes in those needs or plans that don't quite
- 7 materialize.

- 8 Participants Served TWC's General Appropriations Act (GAA) target of 85,068 Participants
- 9 for PY19 is based on our SFY20-21 Legislative Appropriations Request (LAR), which assumed
- a mix of three tiers of service with different cost assumptions:
- Tier I Basic AEL;
 - Tier II Intensive AEL (assumed to cost \$500 more than Basic AEL); and
 - Tier III Integrated Education & Training (IET) AEL (assumed to cost \$1,800 more than Basic AEL).
- 15 While the LAR assumed that we would serve 3,750 in Intensive and 6,500 in IET, those
- numbers are not part of our formal measure. As noted in August, this gives us flexibility in
- both the program/casemix and the distribution of targets.
- 18 Targets approved on August 27, 2019 were based on the "PY19 allocations" but also included
- 19 "Carryforward Targets" because in PY18, 26 of the 36 grantees missed one of more of their
- 20 PY18 Participant Served Targets. Of the 26, staff determined that 6 had "overserved"
- 21 sufficiently in some categories to offset the underservice in others. That left 20 grantees who
- were required to make up **numbers in PY19 as "**Carryforward Targets."
- 23 Therefore, the originally approved PY19 Base and Carryforward Targets aggregated to 4,502
- 24 Intensive, 7,077 IET, and 90,274 Total Participants Served.
- 25 Renegotiations Staff developed a tool which allowed grantees to look at their original
- 26 targets, their progress towards those goals and to test different casemixes to see the impact
- 27 on their targets. This was a zero-sum exercise using the same cost per assumptions as the
- original targets. Grantees have the same amounts "committed to targets" as was the case in
- the original targets, even if the totals in each category or even the overall total changed.
- 30 11 grantees submitted alternate target proposals which staff recommend be approved. This
- 31 table shows the numbers to be served in each category under the original and renegotiated
- targets as well as the differences:
